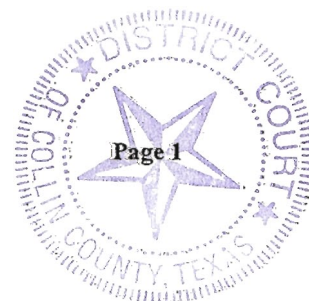

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER – BRENT HANSON

The *ex parte* application of William A. Boothe, M.D. and William A. Boothe, M.D., P.A., Plaintiffs in the above-entitled and numbered cause, for temporary restraining order on their first amended verified petition having been presented on this 20 of January, 2005, and it clearly appearing from the specific facts set forth in said verified petition (1) that immediate, irrevocable injury, loss, or damage will result to Plaintiffs before a hearing can be had on Plaintiffs' Application for Temporary Injunction unless Defendant Brent Hanson is forthwith restrained as prayed for in the verified petition and (2) that permitting Defendant to take any of the acts restrained below would irreparably harm Plaintiffs and (3) that there does not exist sufficient time to serve notice of this *ex parte* application on the Defendant prior to the Court's entry of this Order, and that the failure to grant the *ex parte* application would result in irreparable harm to the Plaintiffs.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Clerk shall issue a temporary restraining order, operative until and pending the hearing below ordered, restricting and enjoining Brent Hanson, his agents, and anyone acting in concert with him --

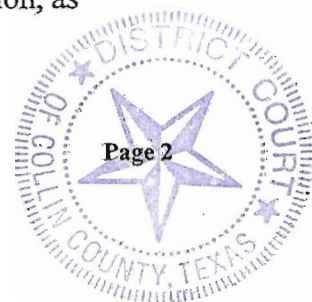
- 1) From coming within 500 feet of:
 - a) Plaintiff William A. Boothe, his wife, or children;
 - b) The residence located at 5204 Lincolnshire Court, Dallas, Collin County, Texas 75287;
 - c) Plaintiffs' place of business at 3900 West 15th Street, Suite 104, Plano, Texas 75075;
 - d) Any individuals known by him to be employees of Plaintiffs;
 - e) Any attorney for the Plaintiffs, at either their place of business or their residences, unless required to do so in connection with legal proceedings;
- 2) From taking any actions that would place Plaintiff Dr. Boothe or his counsel in reasonable apprehension of bodily injury;
- 3) From any communication with any person (other than Hanson's counsel) regarding physical attacks on physicians or their attorneys;
- 4) From expressly or impliedly inciting others in any manner to physically attack physicians or attorneys;
- 5).
 - a) To remove from www.lasikfraud.com, and to refrain from repeating elsewhere, verbatim or in substance, any text or images which threaten any of the Plaintiffs or which constitute false or misleading statements as to any of the Plaintiffs; and
 - b) To refrain from registering any further domain names incorporating "William Boothe," "Boothe Laser Center," or any substantially similar variation thereof; and
- 6) To refrain from sending further email or otherwise communicating with Plaintiff William A. Boothe or his family except through their attorneys; and
- 7) Except as necessary to remove www.lasikfraud.com and content from the Internet, to refrain from destroying, deleting, or transferring any web pages, computer files, emails, correspondence, or other documents or information relating to Plaintiff William A. Boothe, William A Boothe, M.D., P.A., or to www.lasikfraud.com, until such time as judgment has been entered in this case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiffs' application for temporary injunction, as

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

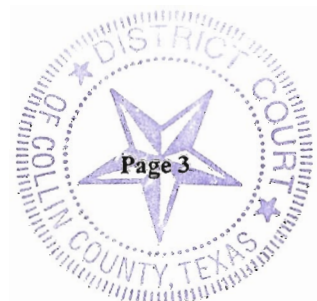

TEMPORARY INJUNCTION

The Application of Plaintiffs for Temporary Injunction (“Application”) having been presented to the Court and hearing having been held on the Application, the Court rules as follows:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Clerk shall issue a temporary injunction, operative until the entry of final judgment in this cause, restricting and enjoining Dan Morikawa, his agents, and anyone acting in concert with him (including, without limitation, Brent Hanson) --

- 1) From coming within 500 feet of:
 - a) Plaintiff William A. Boothe, his wife, or children;
 - b) The residence located at 5204 Lincolnshire Court, Dallas, Collin County, Texas 75287;
 - c) Plaintiffs’ place of business at 3900 West 15th Street, Suite 104, Plano, Texas 75075;
 - d) Any individuals known by him to be employees of Plaintiffs;
 - e) Any attorney for the Plaintiffs, at either their place of business or their residences, unless required to do so in connection with legal proceedings;

- 2) From taking any actions that would place Plaintiff Dr. Boothe or his counsel in reasonable apprehension of bodily injury;
- 3) From any communication with any person (other than Morikawa's counsel) regarding physical attacks on physicians or their attorneys;
- 4) From expressly or impliedly inciting others in any manner to physically attack physicians or attorneys;
- 5) (a) To refrain from posting any text or images which threaten any of the Plaintiffs, or which constitute false or misleading statements as to any of the Plaintiffs, on www.boothelasercenter-review.com, www.boothelasercenterfraud.com and www.drwilliamboothe.com, to refrain from repeating said content elsewhere, verbatim or in substance, including any text or images which threaten any of the Plaintiffs or which constitute false or misleading statements as to any of the Plaintiffs; and
(b) To refrain from registering any further domain names incorporating "William Boothe," "Boothe Laser Center," or any substantially similar variation thereof.
- 7) To refrain from sending further email or otherwise communicating with Plaintiff William A. Boothe or his family except through their attorneys; and
- 8) Except as necessary to remove www.boothelasercenter-review.com, www.boothelasercenterfraud.com and www.drwilliamboothe.com and their content from the Internet, to refrain from destroying, deleting, or transferring any web pages, computer files, emails, correspondence, or other documents or information relating to Plaintiff William A. Boothe, William A Boothe, M.D., P.A, or to one or more of www.boothelasercenter-review.com, www.boothelasercenterfraud.com and www.drwilliamboothe.com, until such time as judgment has been entered in this case;

This Order shall not be effective unless and until Plaintiffs execute and file with the Clerk a bond, in conformity with the law, in the amount of \$ 3,000. The Clerk is directed to apply the


