Mr. Hutson,

I write to you in your capacity as Chapter 13 Standing Trustee of the US Bankruptcy Court of the Middle District of North Carolina. This letter is supplemental to my letter of 26 April 2006 directed to US Bankruptcy Administrator Michael West, in which I alleged bad faith and/or fraud by petitioner Brent A. Hanson.

Subsequent investigation indicates that petitioner may have falsely claimed to be unemployed and without incomeⁱ at the time he filed for bankruptcy protection.

A general investigation related to defamation litigation against Mr. Hanson brought in Sacramento Superior Court, Sacramento County, California has revealed that in the third quarter of 2005 Mr. Hanson earned regular wages of \$8,377.86 as an employee of Snelling Personnel Services, corporate headquarters located at 12801 N Central Express Parkway, Dallas, TX, 75243, contact Barbara McAninch, Chief Legal Officer, 1/800-477-6401 ex.1445. Mr. Hanson filed for bankruptcy protection from his creditors in the third quarter of 2005 and claimed to be without income and unemployed.

Please note that I do not have available the exact dates of employment. I urge you to use your power of subpoena to receive the detailed information necessary to determine if in addition to hiding assets as alleged in my previous letter, Mr. Hanson has also acted in bad faith and attempted to defraud the court and his creditors by hiding income from employment.
